

Government 2.0 Taskforce Request for Project Proposal

Project 13: Gov 2.0 Governance and Institutions: Embedding the 2.0 agenda in the APS

Scope:

Provide advice on organisational and governance reforms to embed the Gov 2.0 agenda within government following the conclusion of the work of the Gov 2.0 Taskforce.

Context:

The Taskforce has been asked to advise Government on structural barriers that prevent and policies to promote open access to public sector information and digital engagement.

This advice needs to take account of existing policies, frameworks and organisational structures including: [AGIMO](#), [the National Archives of Australia](#), [The Office of the Privacy Commissioner](#) and [the Australian Public Service Commission](#). It must also take account of the role of the proposed Information Commissioner.

Objectives:

- Identify local and international best practice examples of organisational and governance arrangements to embed the Gov 2.0 agenda
- Recommend a model for best practice organisational and governance arrangements to embed the Gov 2.0 agenda
- Provide advice on governance arrangements, the role of key agencies and the new Information Commissioner and other key agencies

Deliverables:

A report provided to the Gov 2.0 Taskforce Secretariat via email (gov2secretariat@finance.gov.au) by 30 October 2009.

The report will be in Microsoft Word DOC format, Rich Text Format RTF or OpenDocument Text ODT. It will contain at minimum: executive summary; findings; discussion of issues; and recommendations.

As part of the project, the successful contractor may be asked to provide services to further inform the Taskforce or assist with researching/authoring/editing sections of the Taskforce report. The Taskforce may also request progress reports and/or draft versions of the report be provided, and members of the Taskforce may choose to collaborate with the successful contractor on the project.
